Tuesday, September 3 – Fly Boston-Budapest

Wednesday, September 4 – Budapest (Embark)

Arrive at Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport. We will be greeted by a Uniworld representative and transferred to the S.S. Beatrice.

Thursday, September 5 – Budapest

Located on opposite sides of the Danube, Buda and Pest each has a distinctive character and allure all its own. Enjoy a choice of excursions. In the evening, a special Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner will be prepared for us.

Friday, September 6 – Vienna

A city tour will show us the highlights of the Austrian capital as well as the charming Old Town on a food and art walk of the city. Or, indulge your passion for art on a tour with visits to two distinctively different collections collected by the Habsburgs and the Belvederes.

Saturday, September 7 – Spitz

Find a comfortable seat in the lounge or on the Sun Deck today as our ship cruises through the Wachau Valley toward Spitz.

Sunday, September 8 – Engelhartszell–Passau

Our first German port of call is Passau, where three rivers meet – the Inn, the Ilz, and the Danube. Explore the historic Old Town on a panoramic walk or choose a more active adventure, including a "Curated Service" to tee off at Europe's #1 golf resort.

Monday, September 9 – Regensburg

Bavaria's first capital, Regensburg, owes its impressive historical lineage and rich architectural heritage to 600 years as a Free Imperial City, a fact recognized by UNESCO in 2006. Today, we'll discover how the beautifully preserved medieval city coexists with a vibrant modern urban center.



Tuesday, September 10 – Regensburg–Roth–Nuremberg

Nuremberg will forever be associated with the post-WWII Nuremberg trials but the city's profound historical and cultural significance stretches back many centuries before that. A special Captain's Farewell Reception and Dinner will be prepared for us this evening.

Wednesday, September 11 – Nuremberg (Disembark)


We disembark this morning and set our sights on the “city of a hundred spires” as we transfer by motorcoach to Prague.






Rhine Deck

Staterooms and suites on this deck have French balconies




Danube Deck
